"I do see big floods everywhere – big floods ahead between now and 2013. And this time will be difficult," she said, "but the floods are a cleansing of the earth.

"I don't feel good about it but I think there will be more earthquakes for Japan and there will also be nuclear contamination over Europe.

"The thing is if you squeeze an orange and take the juice out the orange collapses. Mother Earth is a living being and we've taken oil and gas out and now she's reacting.

"There's a lot to be said for clean power, not nuclear power – it's not understood and it can't be controlled by man.

"We'll be in for a bit of a rough ride so people need to have faith."

Ms Miller said commodities could become scarce during this time as Australia relied on a lot of imported products.

"It's a wake-up call – we can't abuse the planet and expect to live off the earth.

"We will need to go back to older ways – instead of being over-sophisticated and trying to get things the easy way.

On the upside Ms Miller said people had become more intuitive.

"I feel we've come to the 11th hour and I'm welcoming it as a big change and people should too.

"Many babies being born are old souls. They are bright cookies who we will need in the world in the future.

"People into drugs are able to open their psychic abilities, but it is the dark force which is why there are so many robberies and armed hold-ups and bad events.

"The good and bad energies are building up. A lot of people are becoming spiritual – not necessarily religious – but spiritual which ultimately will help.

"So I simply want to prepare people to keep their wits about them.

"Everyone has to learn to have a go and believe in themselves. Never be afraid to fly or turn a corner in life."

War and unrest will continue between countries and leaders, according to Ms Miller, but it will come to an end in the next few years.

"I was given a prophecy 30 years ago that in the years ahead Australia will be known as the New Holy Land because we have perpetrated less atrocities than others.

"Ayers Rock (Uluru) will be the heart of the holy land and there'll be an inland sea around it.

"I also feel around Antarctica there'll be a little bit of danger as ice breaks off and causes water levels to rise around Tasmania and southern Australia.

"We will all have to build mental bridges to a better reality.

"And will need to challenge ourselves to do things – even with the world changes – we can all look forward to a new spiritual age. People will learn truer values and appreciate Mother Earth. It will break down barriers between races and cultures.

"Within the next two to three years we will see a path on how to act more honestly and clearly.

"In Amman, near Jerusalem, I feel there'll be something breaking out there soon. And there'll be some retaliation from Gaddafi toward France.

"And I see there will be some light or fire in the sky within the next three weeks."

RHONDA Rixon, another Tweed-based clairvoyant-medium, agreed, saying there was still more to come as the pattern in human life had to change.

"The consciences of all humans has to change; we can't stay stag-

nant and stuck," she said.

"We have needed a lesson in humility to bring back our consciences and that is what I believe is happening.

"We need to learn to work together in the community and be selfless. The greed that has consumed our society has been at the expense of the human race and we will continue to suffer the consequences."

Mrs Rixon, who has been practicing clairvoyancy for more than 30 years, said one of our biggest problems was that no one was working together.

"I believe humans are taking too much oil out of the earth and now mother earth is not running efficiently. And that is why there is so much unrest environmentally and politically.

"If you look at the earth as a body you can see – the earth is erupting and everything is out of

"Mother Nature is hurting and no one is helping so she's going to keep reacting until we do.

"Everything that's going on – people want change in how we use resources and not enough is being done. And we are not working together to put it right and bring it back into balance.

"So all these disasters have absolutely been about bringing people back to focus on consciousness. To focus on all facets of human emotion."

And, according to Mrs Rixon, 2013 will be the year to worry about, not 2012.

"I've been living in the Tweed region for 15 years and I can see in our own local communities that society has become disposable, but we can't function as humans like this.

"We all belong to a team and need to work together – it can't be all about looking after the self."

Mrs Rixon didn't want to ruffle any feathers, but did think the younger generation was too wrapped up in themselves.

"They, on the whole, are particularly selfish. I can see the differences between the generations in my own family. The younger ones are always looking to have a situation that will benefit them – what they can get out of it.

"No one is held accountable to take responsibility for their own actions – not in neighbourhoods, not in schoolyards, not through our court system, not in politics.

"As individuals we have moved so far out of balance and that's why things are crumbling.

But there was a way to move forward.

"We all need to get back to basics – like appreciating your family. We need to grow vegies, collect water and connect with our own families and communities.

"Nobody cares anymore – it's always someone else's problem. There is no one taking control.

"The same is happening with our kids. If they are put in paddocks with no fences they are lost. With no form, structure or guidance we end up with these bullying cases that are destroying kids' lives.

"There is no respect between people and no one is taking responsibility. Until we come together and be truthful – nothing will change.

"So we have natural disasters, global warming, political unrest through greed and bullying.

However, Mrs Rixon said, there is hope.

"There has to be hope," she said, "but I fear things will get worse before they get better because that's what it's going to take."
